Recap on First Camp


- Scandinavia's largest campsite chain with 64 destinations (as of Q1) of which 51 in Sweden, 10 in Denmark and three in Norway.
- Owned by PE fund Norvestor since 2016, and management
- Support offices in Stockholm and Gothenburg
- Approx. 40% of bookings through own website, remainder through call center, drop-ins, OTAs and B2B sales

Highlights of the quarter

Highlights Q1 2023


- Pro forma revenue increase for the first quarter in 2023: +8% compared to Q1 2022
- Good performance of B2B sales, and conference/event market recovering
- Two new destinations Sjöstugans Camping in Sweden and Bø Camping in Norway
- Two more acquisitions signed Tempelkrogen in Denmark and Telemark Kanalcamping in Norway
- Continued strengthening of the organization - increased full-year staffing at the destinations and new capabilities at the support office

Key financials for the quarter

- Total revenue of **81.3** MSEK (59.2)
- EBITDA of **-76.3** MSEK (-52.7)
- Pro forma revenue of **81.1** MSEK (75.3)
- Pro forma Adjusted EBITDA of -76.1 MSEK (-58.3)
- Cash flow from operating activities
 -38.2 MSEK 16.5)



Four acquisitions signed/closed year to date (May 15), adding annual revenue of ~45 MSEK

Sweden


- Pro forma revenue increased with +9% (5.2 MSEK) compared to Q1 2022
- Good performance of B2B/event sales
- Pro forma Adjusted EBITDA reduced with 9.8 MSEK compared to last year – continued strengthening of the organization and cost inflation

Denmark & Norway


- Pro forma revenue increased with +4% (0.6 MSEK) compared to Q1 2022
- Q1 2022 was record first quarter with several large B2B orders
- Pro forma Adjusted EBITDA reduced with 8.0 MSEK compared to last year – same effect as in Sweden from continued strengthening of the organization and cost inflation



- Negative effect from Q4 acquisitions on EBIT with -13.5
 MSEK (as winter months are loss making)
- The IFRS16 effect on EBITDA for the period was 6.4 MSEK
- The IFRS16 effect on EBIT for the period was 2.8 MSEK
- Net financial expenses for the period include 3.0 MSEK interest on Right of Use Liabilities in accordance to IFRS16
- The increase in net financial expenses is a consequence of increase bond loan, and higher interest rate on the bond

- Cash flow from operating activities of SEK -38.2 million reduction from previous year primarily due to lower operating profit, and timing of taxes
- Acquisitions accounted as "Acquisition of subsidiaries" and "Repayment of borrowings" as existing debt in acquired companies was repaid
